ANIMALS MUST BE PRESENT TO BE VACCINATED

Parvo \$8 (per dog)
Distemper/Parvo \$20 (per dog)
Feline Distemper \$15 (per cat)
Dewormer \$5 (per animal)
Bordetella \$12
Rattlesnake \$10

Horses:
Rabies \$10
Coggins Test for Horses \$20
Distemper/Strangles \$20
Flu/Rhino \$15
*West Nile Vaccination \$25
