## 4-H Enrollment

It's enrollment time again. You can enroll/reenroll at [www.4honline.com](http://www.4honline.com) (don't forget to select Texas as your state). Returning members must sign in using email and password already established and update information. New members, must create a family profile, and then add members to the family profile. Registration fees for 3rd grade to 12th grade is \$20 until October 1st then then fee goes up to \$25. Clover kids (kindergarten through 2nd grade) have no registration fee. Adult volunteers must complete a volunteer background check and trainings (these are included with your 4-h connect registration.) We encourage all parents to become a 4-h volunteer. If you need any help signing up, or would like to know more about the 4-h program, please give us a call or come by the Extension Office.

## Validation Information

Don't forget Swine tag orders are due to this office along with payment by September 27th. Tag prices are \$15 a head until October 1st, then price per head goes up to \$18.00.

If you have not paid for your sheep and goat tags, please be sure to do so as soon as possible.

If you plan to only show at the county stock show, county tags are available for \$3 each. Keep in mind the county tags WILL NOT be accepted at major shows. All animals being shown at county must be validated when we do major stock show validations. I will be sending out validation details at a later date.
